Answer the following questions based on your Faith Alive Student Bible (FASB). You don't need to complete all of these questions in one sitting; you may want to divide up your week where you do a few of these each day. Take your time. Read the assigned portions of your Bible and answer the appropriate questions. Parents are encouraged to discuss. We'll cover this Sunday.

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**How is the Bible organized?** (NOTE: this is our Christian version of organization.
