Genesis 12-25

Creation: M Chap. j. of the V



THE FIRST BOOKE OF MOSES, called *Genesis*.

CHAP. I.

1 The creation of Heauen and Earth, 3 of the light, 6 of the firmament, 9 of the earth separated from the waters, 11 and made fruitful, 14 of the Sunne, Moone and Starres, 20 of fish and foule, 24 of beasts and cattell, 26 of man in the image of God, 29 Also the appointment of foode.



In the beginning God created the Heauen, and the Earth.

2 And the earth was without forme, and void, and darknesse was vpon the face of the deepe: & the Spirit of God moued vpon the face of the waters.

3 And God sayd,

Let there be light: and there was light.

4 And God saw the light that it was good: and God diuided the light from the darknes.

5 And God called the light, Day, and the darknesse he called Night: and the evening and the morning were the first day.

6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters: and let it diuide the waters from the waters.

7 And God made the firmament, and diuided the waters, which were vnder the firmament, from the waters, which were aboue the firmament, and it was so.

8 And God called the firmament, Heauen: and the evening and the morning were the second day.

9 And God sayd, Let the waters vnder the heauen be gathered together vnto one place, and let the drye land appeare: and it was so.

10 And God called the drye land, Earth,

and fo: seasons, and fo: dayes and yeeres.

15 And let them bee fo: lights in the firmament of the heauen, to giue light vpon the earth and it was so.

16 And God made two great lightes: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the starres also.

17 And God set them in the firmament of heauen, to giue light vpon the earth:

18 And to rule ouer the day, and ouer the night, and to diuide the light from the darknesse: and God saw that it was good.

19 And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.

20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the living creature that hath life, and fowle that may ffly aboue the earth in the open firmament of heauen.

21 And God created great whales, and every liuing creature that moueth, which the waters brought forth abundantly after their kind, and every winged foule after his kinde: and God saw that it was good.

22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the Seas, and let fowle multiply in the earth.

23 And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the liuing creature after his kind, cattell, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth, after his kinde: and it was so.

25 And God made the beast of the earth after his kinde, and cattell after their kind, and every thing that creepeth vpon the earth, after his kinde: and God saw that it was good.


26 And God said, Let vs make man in our Image, after our likenesse: and let them have dominion ouer the fish of the sea, and

27 And God created man in his own Image, in the Image of God created he him, male and female created he them.

28 And God blessed them, and said vnto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it: and rule over the fish of the sea, and over the fowle of the heauen, and over every living creature that moveth vpon the earth.

29 And God said vnto Adam, Behold, I have given thee every herb bearing seed, which is vpon the face of the earth, for meat: and every tree, the which beareth fruit, thou shalt haue it for meat.

30 And God said vnto Adam, Thou shalt not eat of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and euill: for as soon as thou hast eaten thereof, thou shalt surely die.



Sarai = Princess to Sarah = My Princess.


Yet, Many other scholars will say it's really just a spelling change and Sarai and Sarah both mean Princess.
