


3 THINGS








The Plot to Kill Jesus/ Judas to Betray Jesus




3 THINGS

3. Jesus reveals, “But behold, the hand of him who betrays me is with me on the table. For the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom he is betrayed!”



Jesus Foretells Peter's Denial





The Crucifixion





The Death of Jesus






Jesus is Buried

ointment and spices.




The Resurrection

3. Peter runs to the tomb only to find empty grave clothes.




On the Road to Emmaus


3 THINGS

Himself




3. Their hearts burned

Jesus Appears to His Disciples






