Purposes of miracles

- Confirm the word (Mark 16:20; Heb 2:2-4)
- Produce Faith in Jesus (John 20:30-31)
- Reveal that God is with Jesus (John 3:2)
- Demonstrate that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God (Matt 8:16-17; Isaiah 61:1-2; Luke 4:18-19)

Here's three questions to ask when reading one of Christ's miracles:

- Who benefitted from the miracle?
- Were there any witnesses?
- Besides the miracle itself, is there a bigger meaning/message?
