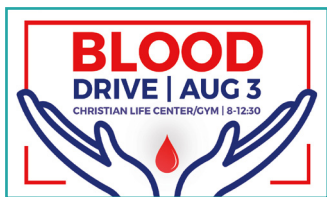
Backpack Blessing

Blood Drive

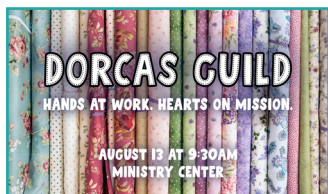
